

## Report for the 3<sup>rd</sup> AAPS-NUS Student Chapter Symposium (5 Mar 2007)

1. **Registration:** 81 participants in total, including 9 students from Republic Polytechnic.
2. **Invited Speakers:** Prof Hans Junginger (Visiting Professor at the National University of Singapore and at the Pharmacy Department of Ljubljana in Slovenia; Guest Professor at the Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Naresuan University, Phitsanulok, Thailand) shared his research experience in transdermal drug delivery. Mr. Chan Tuck Wai (BSc (Pharm) MBA CIP, Senior Manager/ Human Protection Administrator, NUS Institutional Review Board) gave an enlightening talk on ethics in research using human participants.
3. **Chapter Student Presenters:** Postgraduates Ms Tan Lay Hui, Ms Leow Jo-lene and Ms Elaine Tang gave interesting presentations and were awarded with equally good scores in the Podium competition. Undergraduates Ms Ng Chun Chi and Mr Ching Jianhong presented their Honors Year research and Ms Ng was awarded the first prize.
4. **Awards:** Awards were given to all the podium presenters for their excellent performance. Their abstracts were selected for oral presentation from a preliminary judging session by 3 judges. The winners of the poster competition were Dr Dolzhenko, Ms Rachel Ong and Ms Wang Xinqiao.
