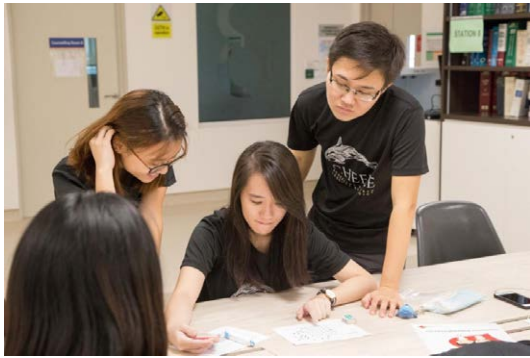

In April 2018, our final year student, Azrina Imran Tan (Class of 2018), was crowned the World Champion in the Inter-regional Patient Counselling Event Competition.

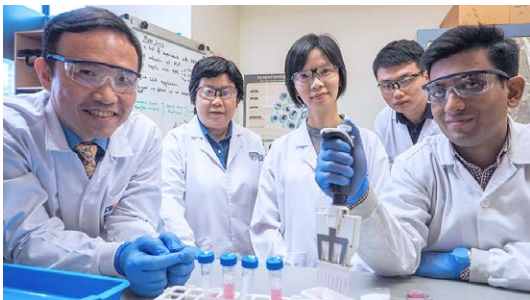
